



HERITAGE

Built in 1897 by architect Daniël Knuttel as the Rijkspostspaarbank, the building that is now Mandarin Oriental Conservatorium, Amsterdam, has a rich and layered history. Originally a bank, it helped spark the regeneration of Amsterdam's museum quarter, standing alongside the Rijksmuseum as a symbol of commercial and cultural prosperity. After the bank closed in 1978, the building was transformed into the Sweelinck Conservatorium, with offices converted into acoustic classrooms where generations of music students performed.

In 2011, it reopened as the Conservatorium Hotel, and in 2026 it transitioned to Mandarin Oriental Conservatorium under new management, continuing its legacy as a gathering place for commerce, culture, and society.




EVENT VENUES

SYMPHONY ROOM

Positioned on the third floor with views across the courtyard, into the atrium and of the hotel's historic façade, the Symphony Room is an illustrious space ideal for grand occasions.

The room is 120 sqm large and has high ceilings. It can host lunches or dinners for a maximum of 90 guests, 120 guests in theatre setting and numerous types of receptions for a maximum of 130 guests. It usefully has a satellite kitchen located next door.

With its floor to ceiling windows, the Symphony Room has an abundance of natural daylight and is equipped with state-of-the-art high definition technology, including a built-in beamer and a remote control system for every need and comfort.




HARMONY ROOM

The Harmony Room is located on the second floor, peering down on the central cavity of the hotel's inner atrium through floor-to-ceiling glass windows. The room seems to hover imposingly just above the lobby, enjoying the ambiance below, yet being slightly removed from it, which adds to the intimate atmosphere. The 36 sqm space overlooking the glass atrium is the perfect venue to host more exclusive and private events.

It can welcome 22 guests for private dining or up to 35 guests for standing functions with cocktail tables. The Harmony Room can hold 20 guests seated in a boardroom format or 30 guests in a theatre setting.

The Harmony Room is equipped with state-of-the-art high definition technology, including a beamer and a remote control system for every need and comfort.

ORANGE ROOM

The Orange Room has 16 sqm of space and a maximum capacity of eight guests in a fixed boardroom and dinner set-up. It is positioned at the corner of the glass building, providing stunning views over the atrium and historic building and a special, intimate private dining option. The Orange Room also offers a built-in LCD screen which can be used for presentations.

PENTHOUSE SUITE

Constructed almost entirely out of glass, positioned on the sixth floor with views across the courtyard and into the building's historical façade, the Penthouse Suite is an extravagant and elegant space for various occasions.

The suite is 170 square metres large and its floor-to-ceiling windows allow an abundance of natural daylight. It can welcome up to 12 guests or a boardroom meeting or up to 25 guests for standing functions. The Penthouse boasts an 80-inch monitor screen and remote control system for every need and comfort.


Penthouse Suite



CONCERTO SUITE

The Two-Bedroom Concerto Suite is lit by sets of extraordinary historic windows, arranged like the pipes of an organ, which are visible on the neo-gothic façade of Mandarin Oriental Conservatorium. This 95 square metres space overlooking the hotel's courtyard is the perfect venue to host more exclusive and private events.

It can welcome up to 15 guests for standing functions and up to eight guests for private dining. The split-level suite is arranged with a sitting room, dining room and kitchenette.






DELUXE SUITE








