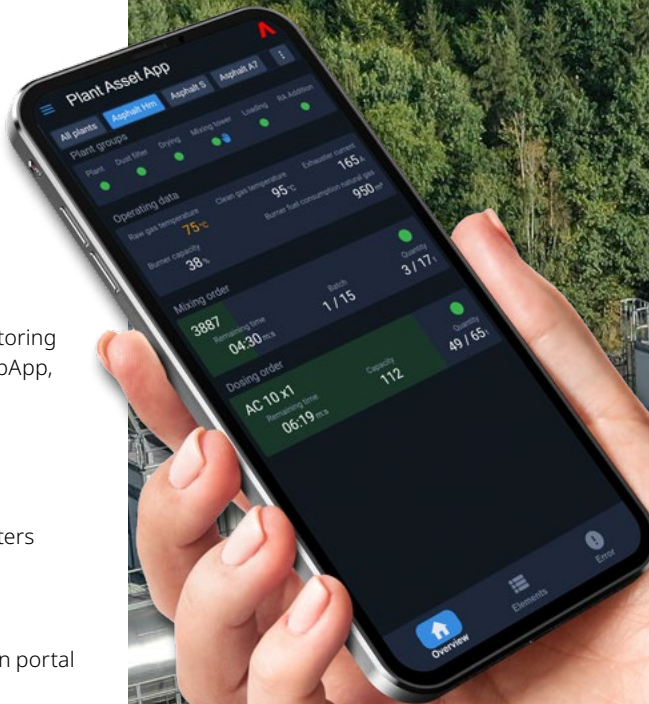

Created to empower users with remote monitoring and maintenance assistance. Provided as WebApp, available via internet.

- Multi-Plant status overview
- Detailed plant status view
- Element list with status
- Element detail view with status, event counters and I/O views
- Warning and fault list
- No hardware installation needed
- Multi-user capable, with a self administration portal
- Several user roles are available, enabling more/less view details and/or actions



Multi-Plant & Single-Plant Status View

- See the actual status of all your connected plants with enabled PAA;
- Drill down into details of a selected plant to see:
 - Status of plant groups;
 - Given KPI values;
 - If and which recipe is in production with remaining time and quantity.

I/O View & Notes

- See the actual status of assigned input or output signals;
- Create and store notes for an element;
- Add pictures into notes;
- Notes can be read from others in their PAA.

Error list view

- See all active warnings and errors of the selected plant;
- Directly enter an element to see live status, e.g. I/O status;
- If available, open electrical diagrams directly from the I/O list.

Asset group and element list with status

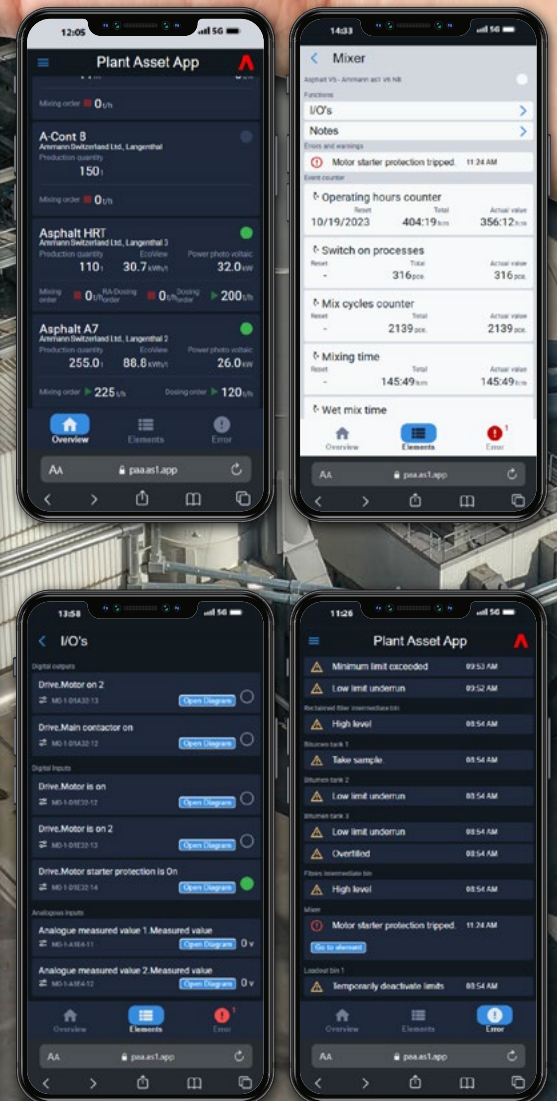
- See the actual status of all controlled plant elements;
- Drill down further into details of a selected group or element;
- See operating hours and other event counters.

Theme support

Switch between light & dark theme to have best view experience in your environment.

Plant service status – End customer View

- Create and invite users with specific, basic view rights;
- Let your staff know if plant status is OK or not;
- Let your customers know if there is an issue on the plant, so they can act accordingly.
